It is very important to the Stockbridge Flower & Farmers' Market @ GO BREW as a whole and to your customers, your fellow vendors that all of these rules and regulations are read and adhered to by everyone.

1. Vendors are responsible for notifying the Market Managers when they will not be at the Market as scheduled. Please contact one of these three people:

2. Vendors must keep within their designated area, not interfering with walk ways, driveways, or their neighboring vendors.
 - * On their first offence the vendor will receive a verbal warning.
 - * On their second offence the warning will be in writing.
 - * On the third and subsequent offence they will be fined \$50 with payment due by the end of that Market Day.
3. All vehicles belonging to the vendor and their workers must be parked away from the market or totally inside their allotted area.
4. If you decide to leave the Farmers' Market, your deposit will not be refunded if the Market Manager has not notified in writing by April 1st.
5. Vendors will not be allowed to have more than four (4) stalls.
6. Vendors must keep their area clean and free from garbage.
ALL GARBAGE IS TO BE REMOVED FROM YOUR STALL AND TAKEN HOME OR TO THE DUMP AT THE END OF THE MARKET DAY!
7. Vendors must be at the Market in their assigned spaces by 8:00am. Vendors shall not leave before 1:00pm on Market day as it could jeopardize the safety of other vendors and shoppers if your vehicle is part of your space rental.
8. All accidents or mishaps must be reported to the Market Manager and any complaints brought to his attention.
9. Vendors must display their name in plain sight for all customers to see. Awnings and other shade devices shall not interfere with the flow of the customer traffic. Awnings and shade devices must be high enough to allow customers to walk under them without having to worry about hitting their heads. Awnings and shade devices must be securely anchored or weighted down so that they can not be dislodged under normal circumstances, such as a Midwest wind gust.

RULES & REGULATIONS

10. Vendors must meet all Municipal, Regional, Provincial and Federal laws regarding food handling and preparation. Vendors are not allowed to cook and sell food on the Market as it would interfere with the designated Market food vendor agreement.
11. Vendors do not have the Right to sub-let, sell, transfer or permit anyone else to use their area without the written approval of the Market Manager.
12. Sales shall be conducted in an orderly manner. No undercutting of prices will be allowed at any time. We want to establish and maintain a small town country market atmosphere with friendly vendors.
13. A minimum deposit of 10% of the yearly space rental fee is to be paid by April 1, and the balance paid full by the first Market day in April. Vendors wishing to return next Market season must make a 10% deposit by October 31, the last Market week of the year. This is to reserve their area for the next market season. Deposits will not be returned after March 1st of the Market Year. Failure to pay on time will jeopardize the vendor's chance to occupy the same area the following Market Year.
14. Vendors may not add merchandise to their approved list without the written approval of the MARKET MANAGER.
15. GO BREW GARDENS reserves the right to change Market days and location within the Market area. No refund or compensation can be paid, however, another date may be assigned to replace a cancelled event.
16. GO BREW GARDENS has the right to cancel any vendor's season area when, in the opinion of the Market Management, they have willfully violated the Rules and Regulations governing this Market.
17. Vendors who are absent without notice for 3 market days in a row will relinquish their assigned space to allow it to become available to another vendor. **GOAL IS TO HAVE THE MARKET WELL STOCKED AND STAFFED EVERY WEEKEND!**
18. Stockbridge Area Flowers & Farmers' Market opens the last weekend in April and closes the last Saturday of October each season.
